



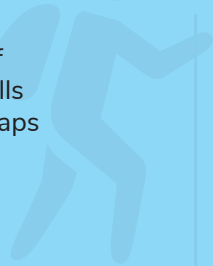
Property Strategy (2019 - 2029)

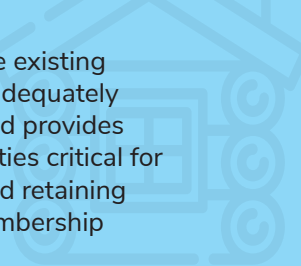
New Groups Facilities

The development of new Groups and halls to address facility gaps



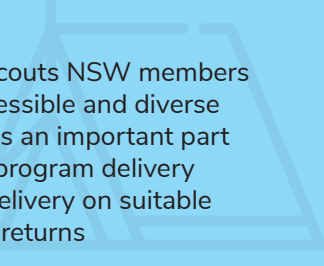
Existing Group Facilities

Ensuring the existing network is adequately balanced and provides quality facilities critical for servicing and retaining existing membership



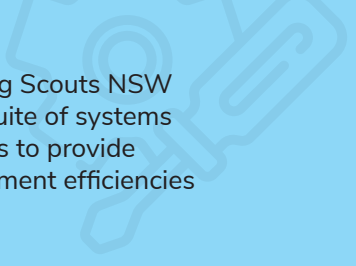
Adventure Facilities
