3	Awarding of the Baden Powell Scout Award gets recommended by the Region Rover Council
4	Region Rover Council forwards the form to the Branch Rover Council and cc'ed to the Awardee and their Rover Unit.
5	Branch Rover Council delegate emails (preferred) form to the State Office (PeakAwards@nsw.scouts.com.au) and cc'ed to Rover Unit, District Commissioner/ Leader Rover Scouts or appropriate person at the District level and the Group Leader, or Leader-In-Charge, of the Scout Group.
6	Branch/State Office receives Baden Powell Scout Award Notice of Completion form via email (preferred) or mail.
7	Branch/State Office to add recipient's award to membership record.
8	Branch/State Office to mail the award to the address nominated on the form.
9	Unit to arrange awarding the recipient and advises District/Region of ceremony.
10	Branch/State Office puts recipient on roll for the next State Award Presentation.
