Upcoming Grant Opportunities and Webinars

Clubgrants Category 3 Fund, Infrastructure Grants, is an NSW Government-administered program that offers grants of between \$10,000 and \$200,000. This is available to communities across NSW to support the building, renovation and fit-out of community infrastructure with the following categories:

- Arts & Culture: \$50,000 to \$200,000 available per project
- Community Infrastructure: \$10,000 to \$200,000 available per project
- Disaster Readiness: \$10,000 to \$200,000 available per project
- Sport & Recreation: \$50,000 to \$300,000 available per project

Grant application dates are from Monday 1 November to Monday 22 November 2021.
