

Scouts NSW Roadmap: Return to Face-To-Face Scouting



This plan is based on information provided in the NSW Freedoms for fully vaccinated people as published on the NSW Government website. All dates are based on predictions of vaccination rollout and will depend on public health advice as to the current epidemiology. In addition, easing at 70% and 80% fully vaccinated will be subject to health system capacity

Phase D plan is dependent on an updated National Plan to transition Australia's National COVID-19 Response by Commonwealth government.
